#### Summary Information

#### Further Breakdown of the Housing Placement Results:

Of those who scored a **10 or higher** on the VI-SPDAT (the most vulnerable):

- **12 out of 76 (16 %)** persons have been housed.

#### Demographic Information (of those housed):

- 13 female, 19 male
- Average time of homelessness: 5 years
- Average time of homelessness of most vulnerable (10+): 8 years
- 24 persons have experienced at least 1 year of homelessness
- 15 persons have experienced at least 5 years of homelessness
- Two individuals now housed have been homeless for 20 years

#### Other Progress:

The Burlington Housing Authority "Shelter plus Care" Program is now fully utilized.

There are currently 5 more individuals who will soon be housed (all of which were found to be highly vulnerable with 10+ score).

- All 5 individuals are connected with services and engaged.
- 3 individuals currently have rental subsidy vouchers and are looking for units.
- 2 individuals are in the process of obtaining subsidies.
