Further Breakdown of the Housing Placement Results:

Of those who scored a **10 or higher** on the VI-SPDAT (the most vulnerable):

- 9 out of 62 (14.5%) persons have been housed.
- Monthly housing rate since Registry Week: 3.6%

Of those who scored **5 to 9** on the VI-SPDAT:

- 13 out of 96 (13.5%) persons have been housed.
- Monthly housing rate since Registry Week: **3.3%**

The individual who scored **16** on the VI-SPDAT (the highest score recorded) has been housed.

Demographic Information (of those housed):

- 9 female, 14 male
- Average time of homelessness: 4 years

- 19 persons have experienced at least 2 years of homelessness
- 5 persons have experienced at least 5 years of homelessness
- One individual now housed has been homeless for 20 years
